- All competitors are required to check-in on the day they compete. Each day of competitive events, there will be an assigned time to check-in. At the end of the check-in time, students who have checked in will be shifted up to earlier open time slots (left open by students who have not signed in) & adjusted times will be posted on the doors. Those who register late will be moved to the later time slots. NO STUDENTS WILL BE DENIED THE OPPORTUNITY TO COMPETE; provision will be arranged, but they must arrive before the last person competes. Judges will not be expected to wait around to see if competitors show up.
- Competitors will be assigned a time to compete. They will be expected to arrive 15 minutes before their assigned time.
- If there is a scheduling conflict, competitor must inform the judge at check-in so accommodations can be made.
- If the competitor is not there at his/her scheduled time, the next in line will move up to that time slot.
