	Junior Varsity (JV) – This is for members in 9 th & 10 th grades.
	Varsity (V) – This is for members in 11 th & 12 th grades.
	Collegiate – This is for students who have graduated high school
	and who are attending an institution of higher education. This is
	not for dual credit or collegiate academies in high school.
	Special Edition (SE) – This is for students who are on an IEP. It is
	specifically designed to accommodate special needs students
	who need accommodations to compete in the competitions.
